

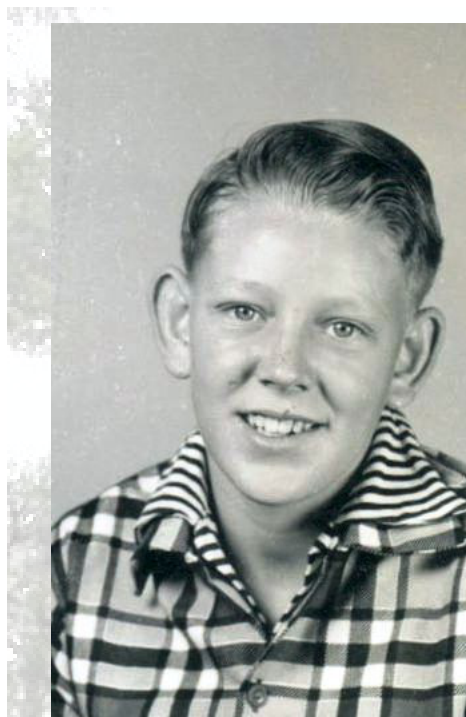
## Samuel Franklin Cheatham

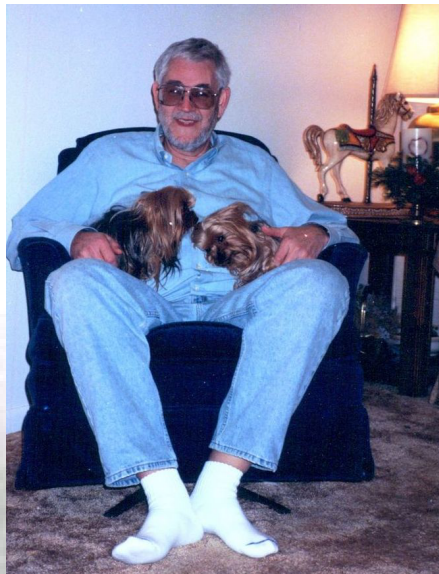
