

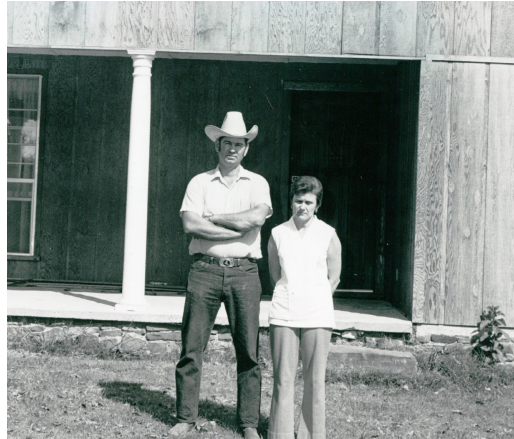
## Virginia Kay Cluck
