

## **Death of Mr. John W. Cohea.**

Mr. John W. Cohea died at his home near Prairie View school house, six miles North of Prairie Grove, Tuesday evening, Sept. 12th, at 6 o'clock, following an illness of several weeks with heart trouble.

Mr. Cohea was born April 1, 1847, in the same neighborhood where he died. He lived on a part of the farm where his father lived for 62 years. His life has been spent on the farm, and was a man held in high esteem by all who knew him. On Aug. 19, 1869, he was united in marriage to Miss Susan R. Cherry. To this union were born eleven children, eight of whom survive him, and were all present at the funeral Wednesday.

He made a profession of faith in Christ when a young man, and while he never united with the church, he lived a clean upright life.

The funeral service was held Wednesday afternoon at 4 o'clock, and was conducted by Rev. J. F. Parker, assisted by Rev. J. F. McQuiston and Rev. Sam Farmer. The burial was made in the Rose graveyard.
