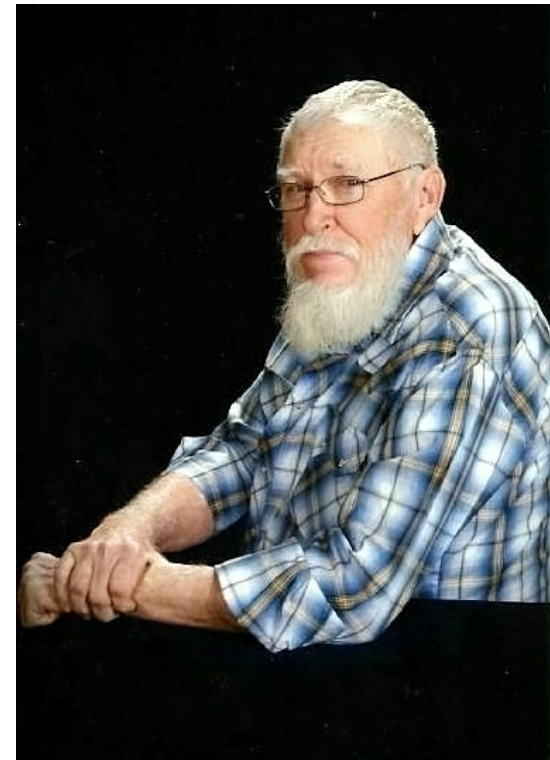

Kenneth Wayne Cooper
