Lee has been a resident and business owner in Prairie Grove all of his life. 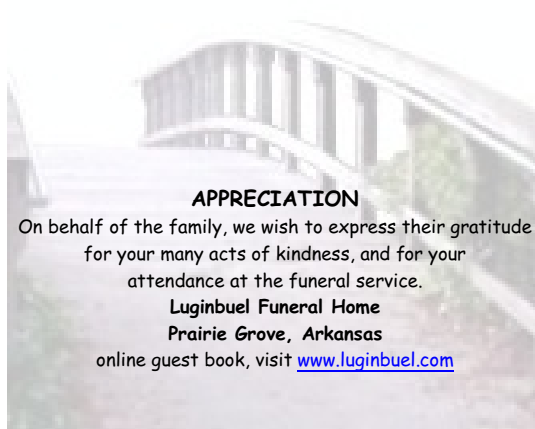
