She was preceded in death by her husband Bill Crooks, her parents and one sister Kate Estle.

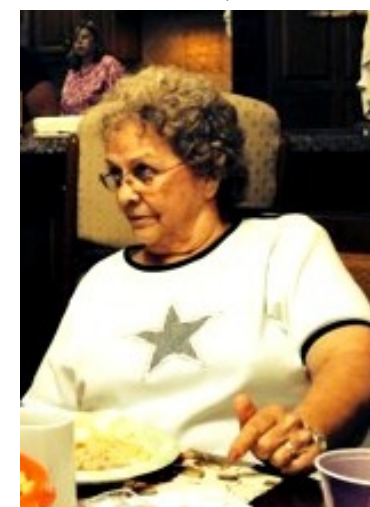
