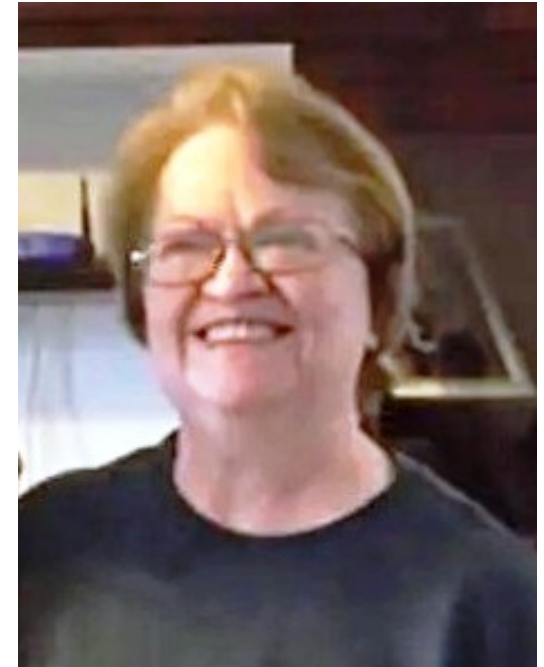
Five great grandchildren: Rosslyn, Elsie, and Rosemary Winter; Paxton and Bowen Allen.
