Sharon worked as a teachers aid for 28 years in the Lincoln School District.

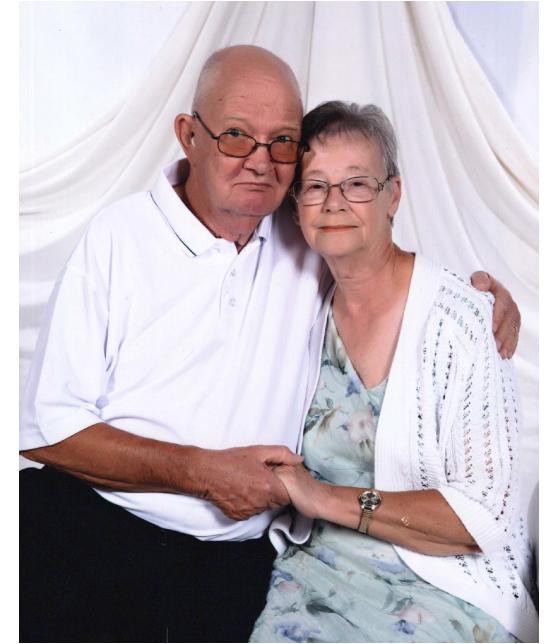
She was preceded in death by her parents and one granddaughter Minnie Davis.
