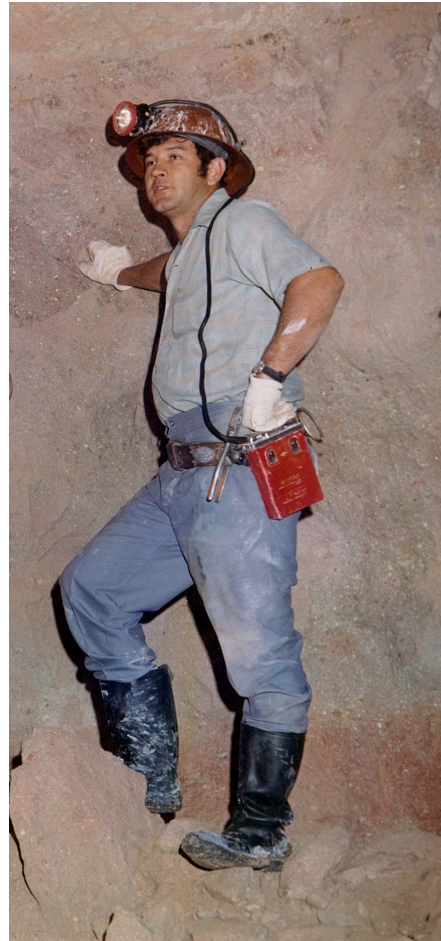


Jay Estes DiCamillo
