

Wilma Lee Dobbs

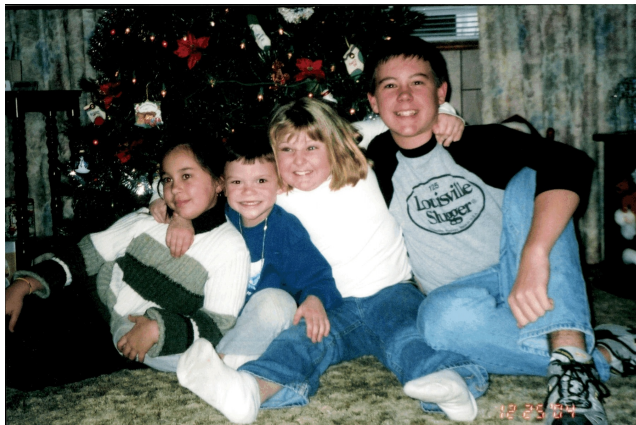
