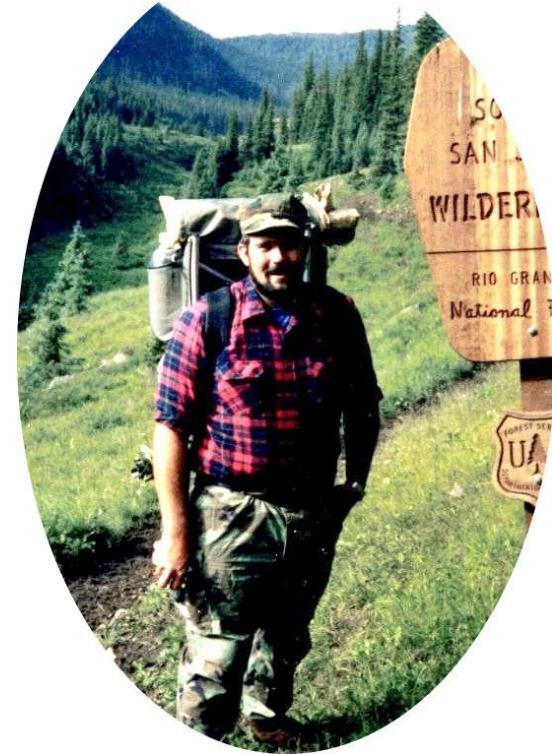

James Dale Foster
