

Lorenza Freeman

Lorenza Freeman was born in Cherokee county Georgia, Feb. 10, 1860; died Jan. 5, 1927. His parents moved to Yell county Arkansas when he was a boy. He was converted at 18 and joined the Methodist church. He afterwards changed his membership to the Cumberland Presbyterian church at Mt. Pleasant. He was married to Rosalie Adams, June 18 1881. To them 9 children were born, 4 of whom are living: Mrs. Bertha Edmiston, Mrs. Dorcia Ham and Mrs. Zella Gray all of Coffeyville, Kansas, and Garland Freeman of Vinita, Okla. Mrs. Freeman died Feb. 2, 1900. He married Clara Simpson, May 29, 1902. To them were born 3 children—only one living, now, Zelda B. Freeman also of Coffeyville, Kansas. All the children were present at the funeral which was conducted by Rev. S. E. Marrs at Edmiston cemetery.
