She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Prairie Grove.

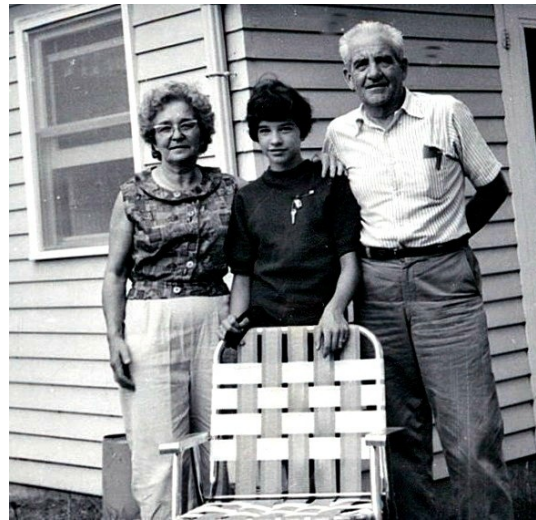
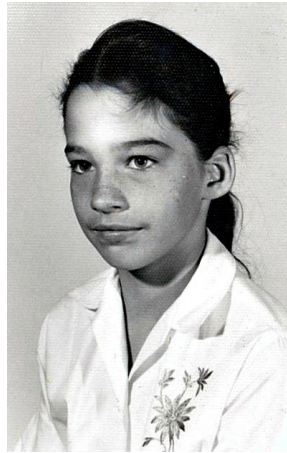
She was raised on the family farm in the Clyde Community. She was a graduate of the Lincoln High School in 1971 and attended the University of Arkansas.
