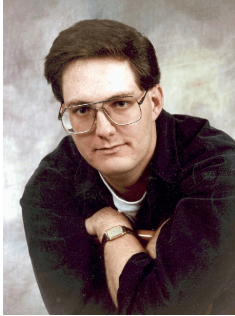


Jimmy Charles Gibney
