He was preceded in death by his father and one sister Janetta Carol Pearson.

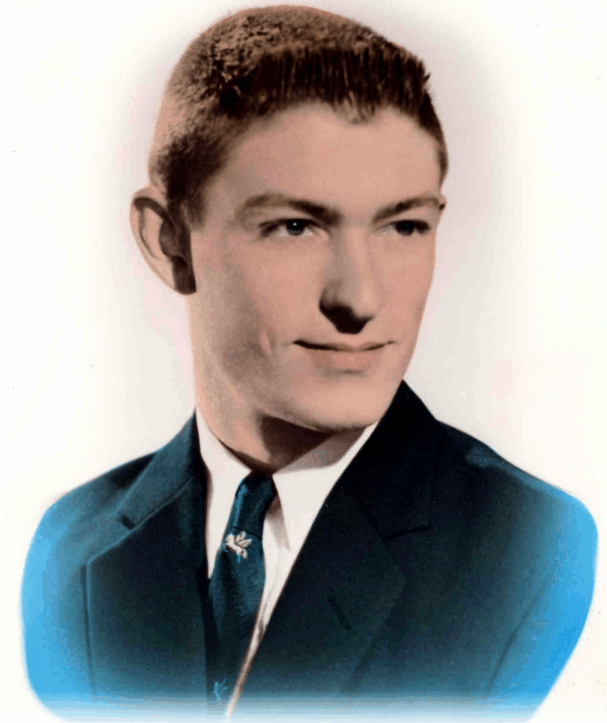
