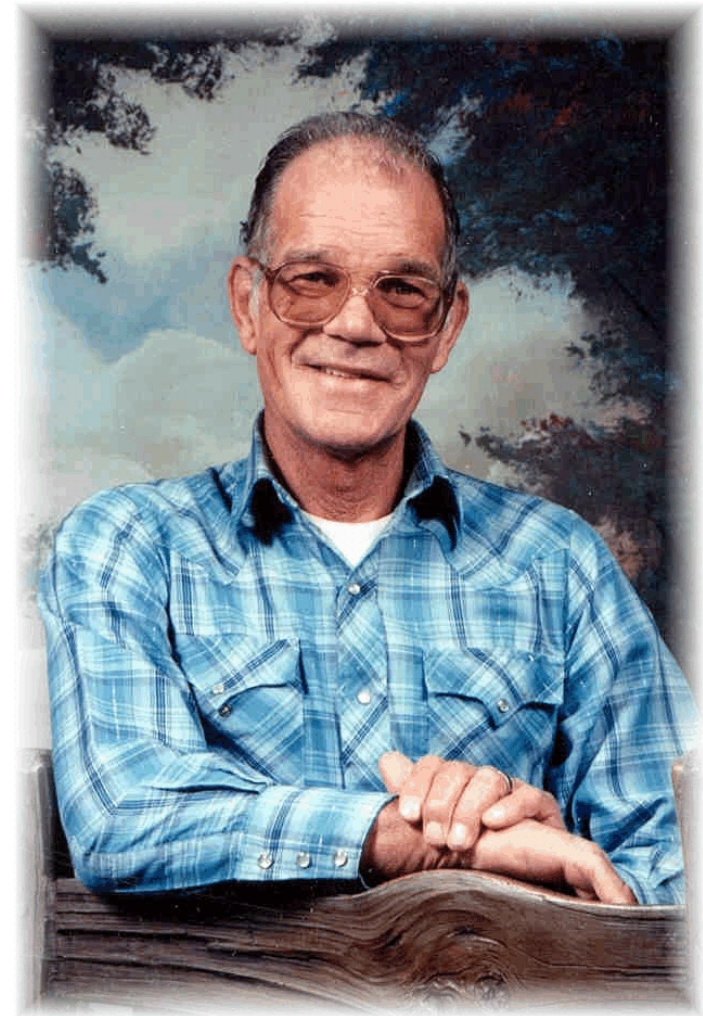
He was preceded in death by his mother, father, three brothers, two sisters and four grandchildren.
