

Kathy Lynn Gubitz

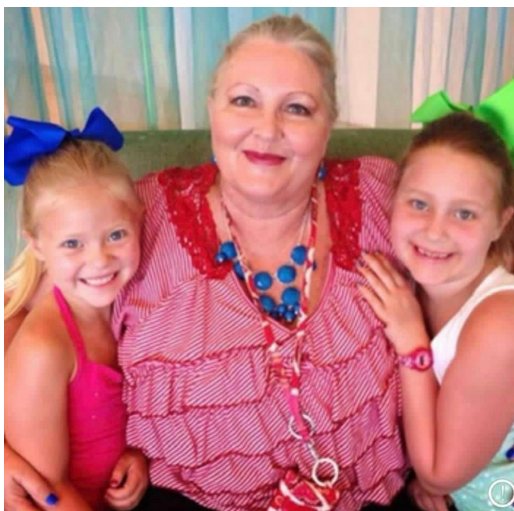
