

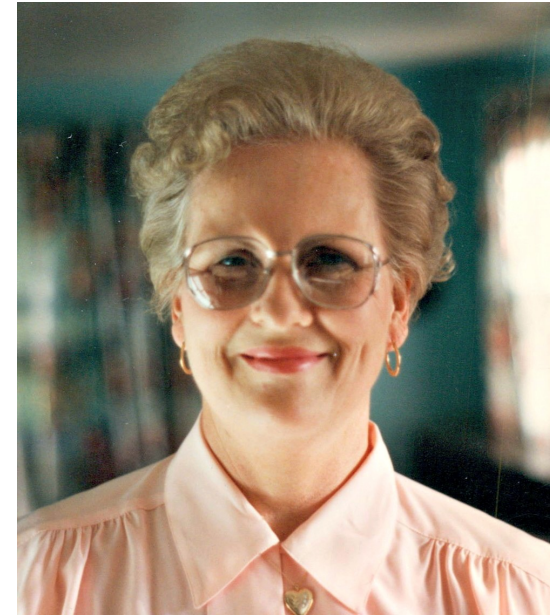
**Jacqueline Sue Hale**
