

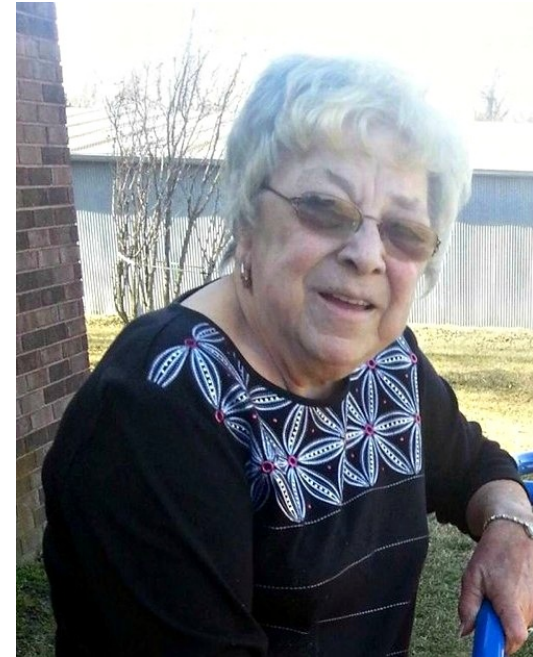
Charlotte LaVaughn Hammond
