

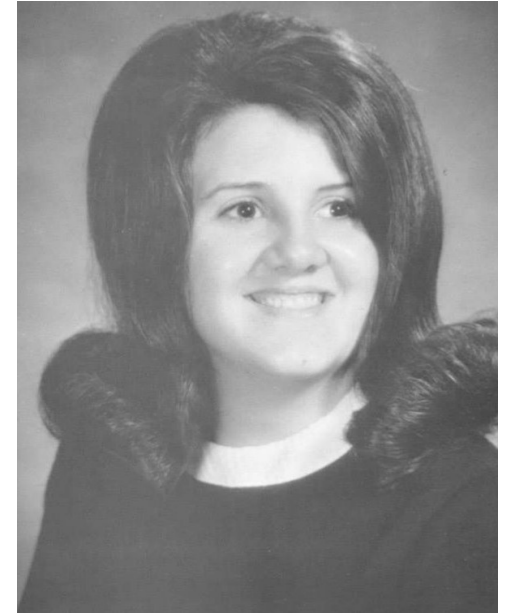
Loamma Jean Holcomb
