

Roy Carson Hummel



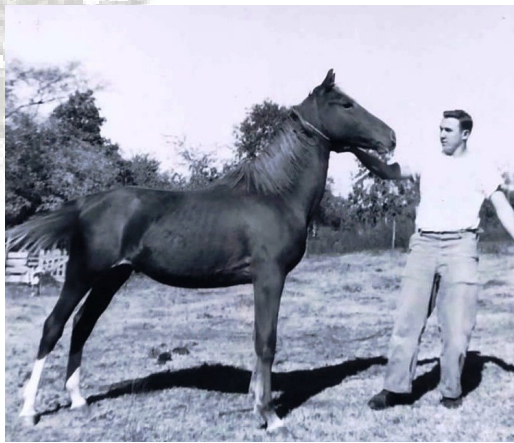
