

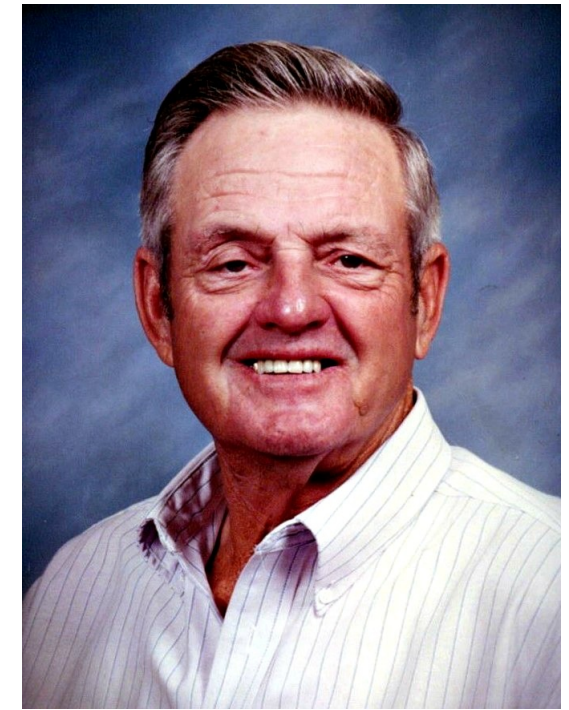
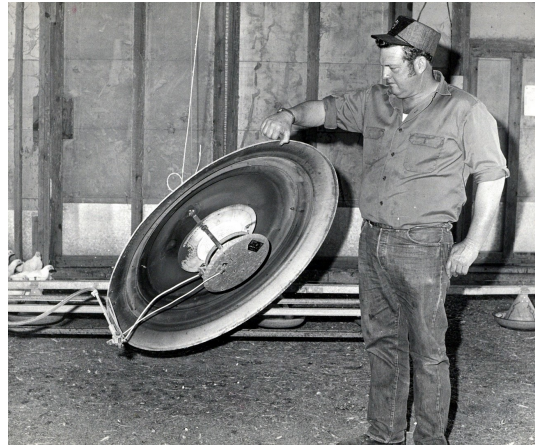
Floyd Ray Icenogle
