He was preceded in death by one grandson, Jesse Wayne Howard.

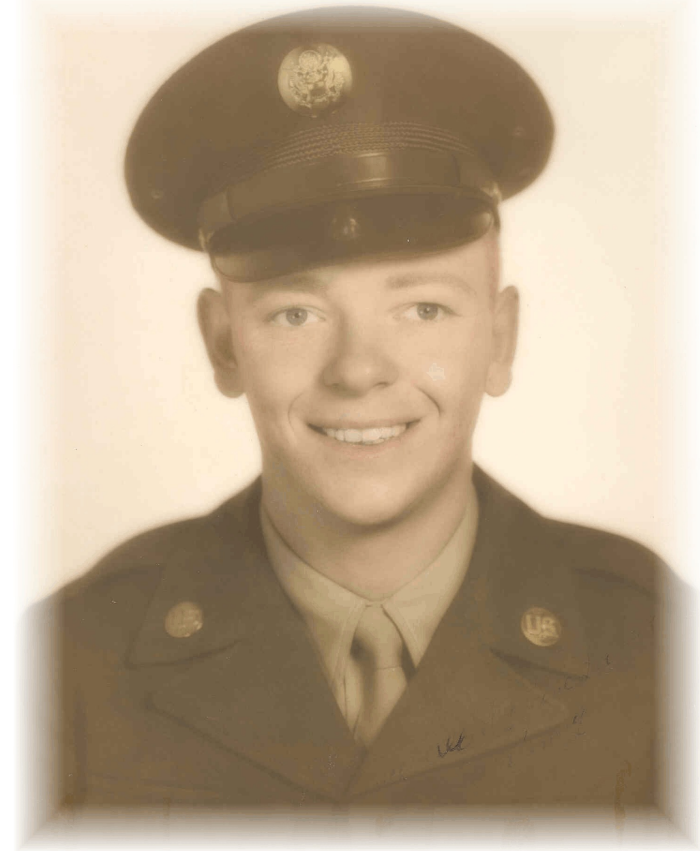
