

Roy A. Jansson

Age 78, a resident of Farmington, Arkansas, passed away Saturday, February 11, 2023 at his home. He was born July 29, 1944 in Glendale, California, the son of Roy A. and Ruby Lee (Bowman) Jansson.

Roy grew up in Western Oklahoma.
