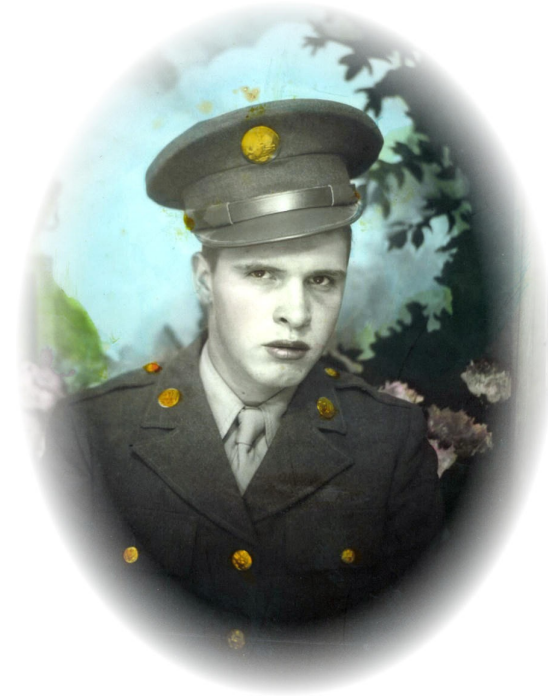

James Albert Johnson
