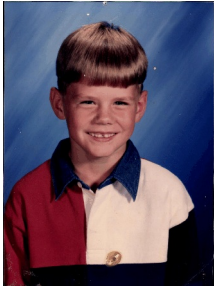


Wesley Garrett Johnson
