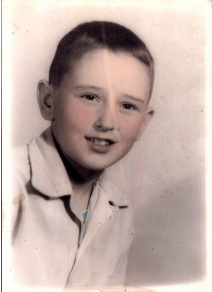


Harold Rae Kelly
