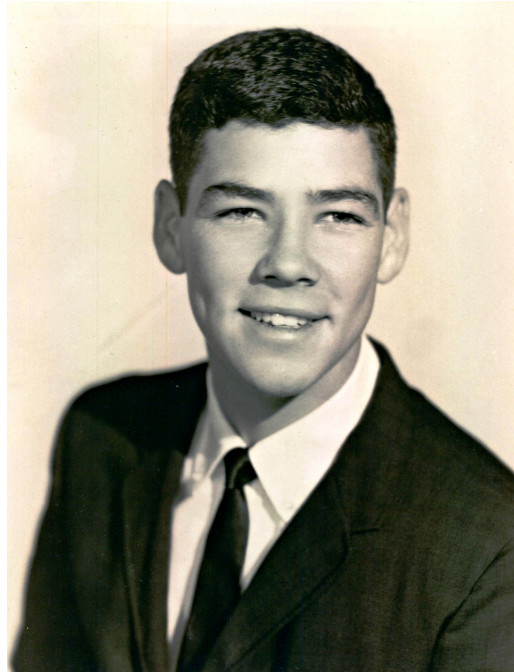


Johnny Lee Lawrence
