



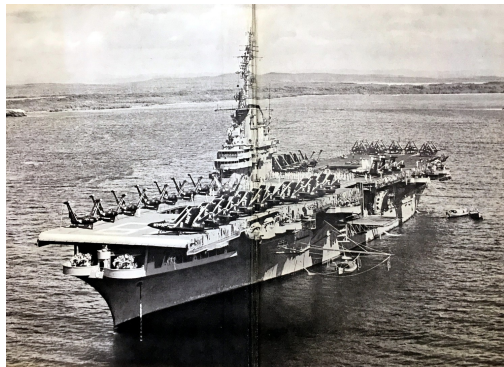
Donald Lee McLeod
