Though Jacob faced many challenges in his life, he never lost his ability to find humor in a situation. He was, at his core, a kind person with a gentle heart and a devoted, loving son who will be missed by all who knew him.

He is survived by his mother, Lynn Ann Davis; her husband, Tommy; his aunt, Cathy Patterson; his uncles, Buddy Patterson and Alan Bland; his cousins, Seth and Caleb Patterson, and his cat MuMu. He was preceded in death by his father, Dan McWhorter, his Granny and Pa, and his uncle David Bland.


