

Daniel (Dan) Montgomery age 61 of Lincoln, Arkansas passed away on Saturday May 20, 2023 at his home.

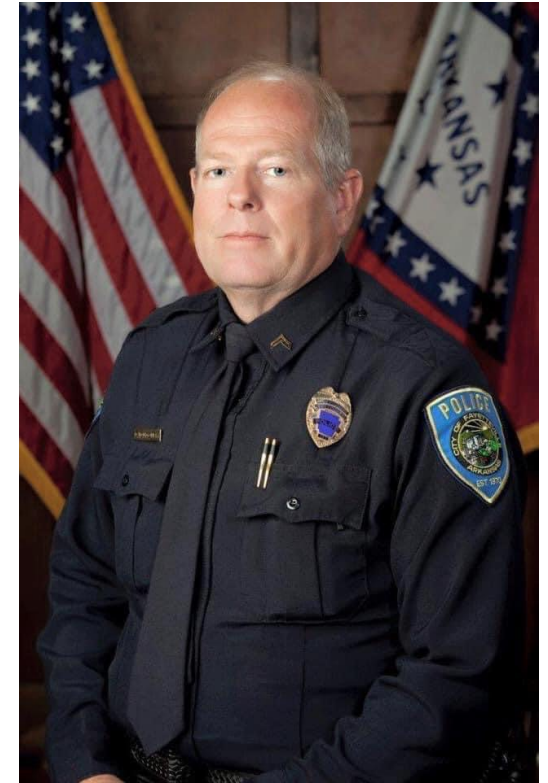
