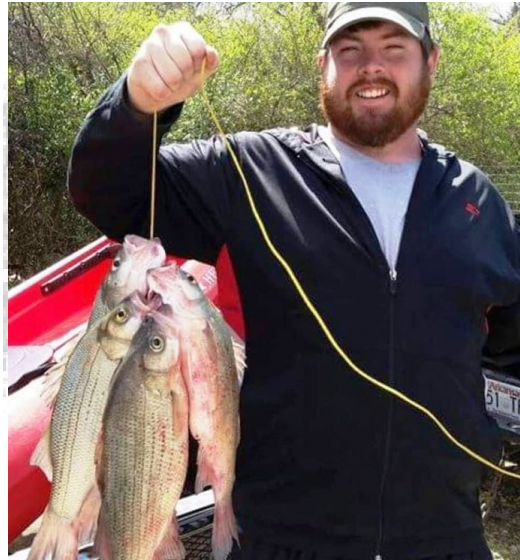


### **Brandon Norman Moore**
