Erma will be remembered for her dedication to family, her steady work ethic, and her love of fellowship, travel, and community. Her memory will be cherished by all who knew her.



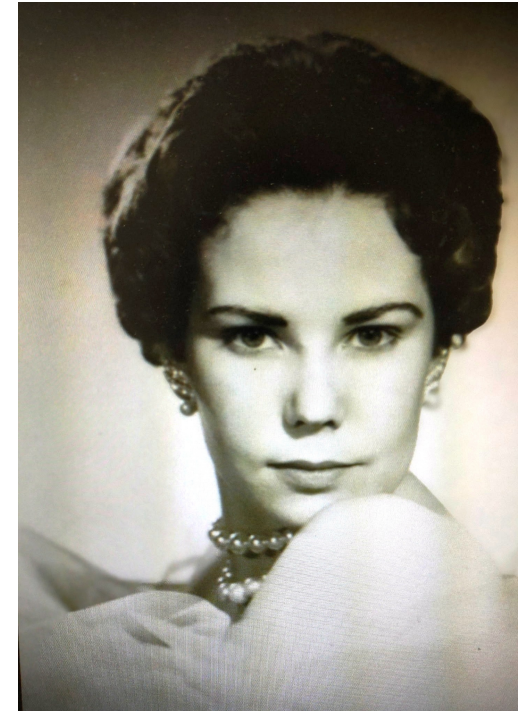
