She was preceded in death by one son, Jerry Lynn Johnson; three brothers, Angelo Errichetto, Thomas Errichetto and Joseph Errichetto.

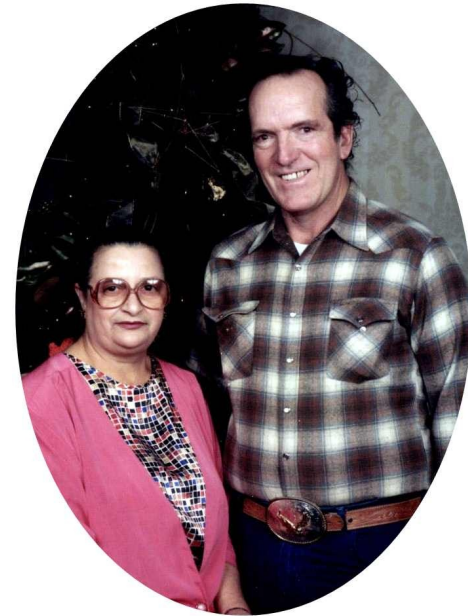
