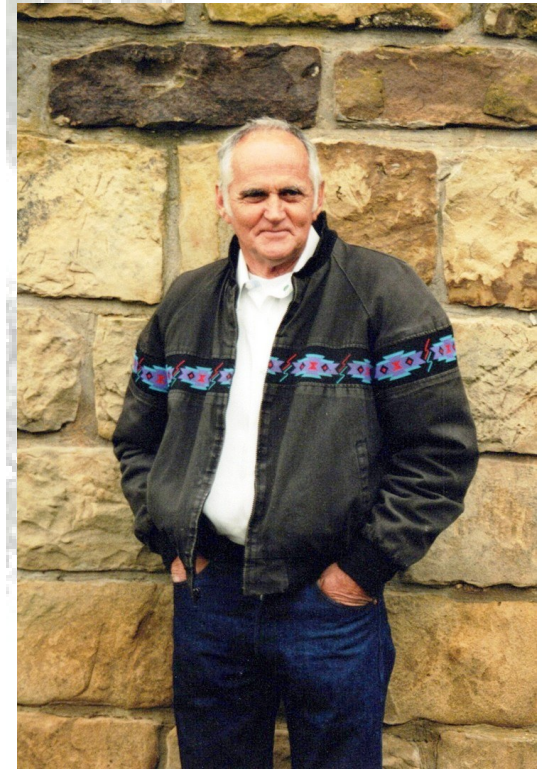
The family would like to express their deepest appreciation to the staff at Willard Walker Hospice Home for the care given to Onnie.
