

Donald Wayne "Don" Pittman

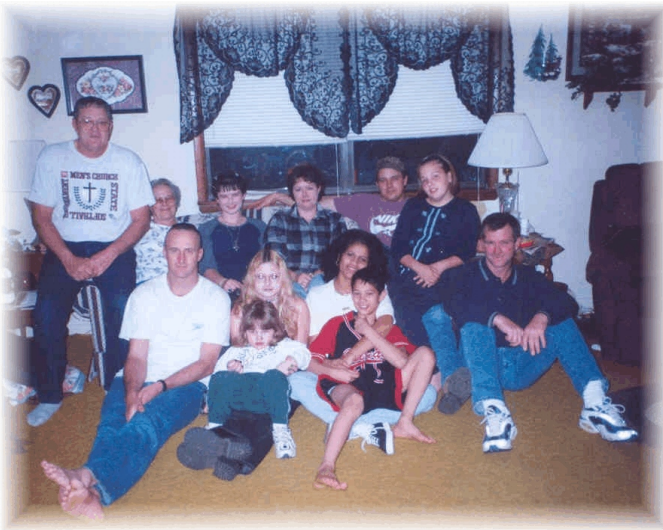
