He was preceded in death by his parents, and many aunts and uncles.

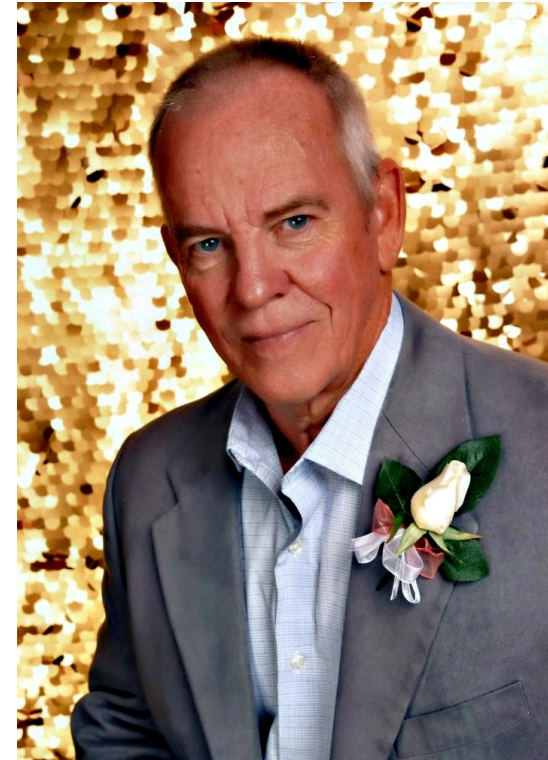
