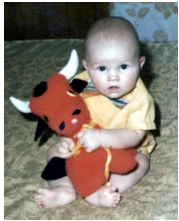


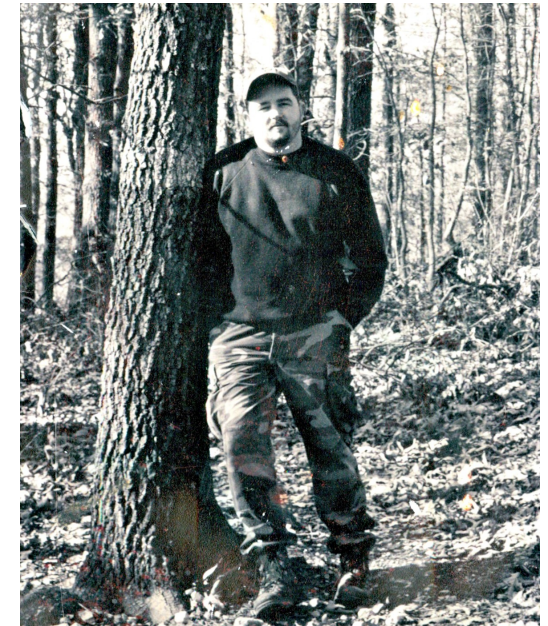
Tracy "Trey" Dale Preston
