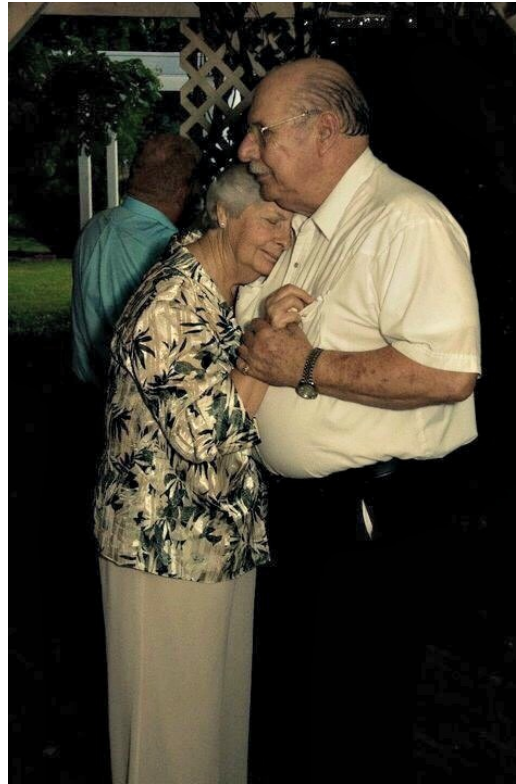


Zona Lorraine Ray
