He was preceded in death by one son, Dennis Ivan Reed; his mother and father; three brothers, Harold Reed, Kenneth Reed, and Robert Reed.

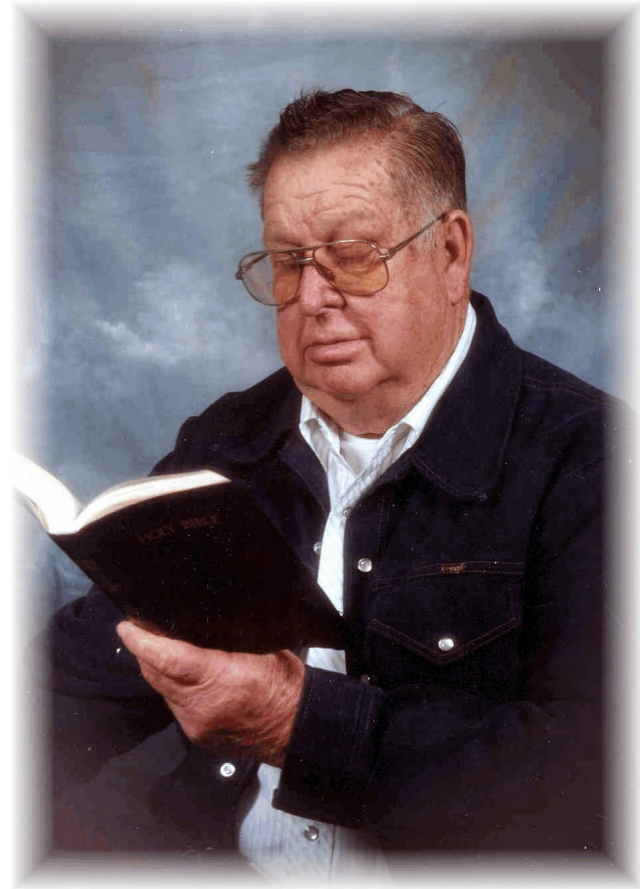
