She was preceded in death by her paternal Grandparents Elven and Wilma Dean Cheatham.

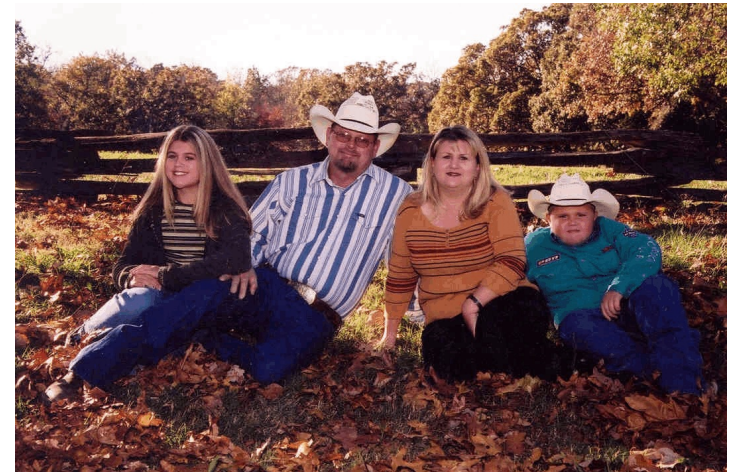
