
Jack Allison Reed Jr.

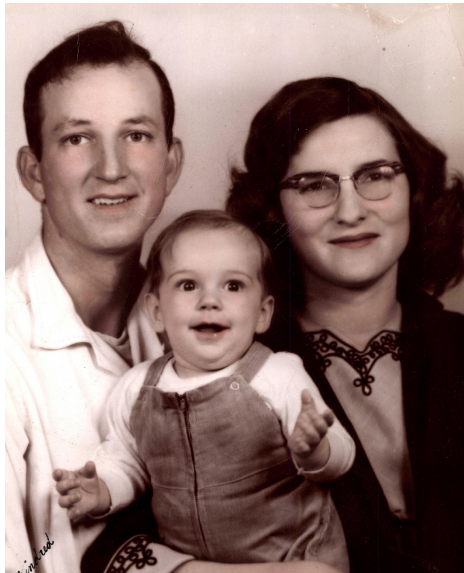
