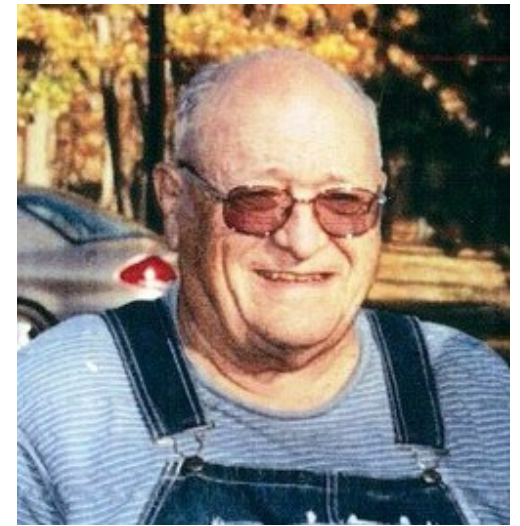
WB retired from the United States Navy with over 25 years of service. He went on to retire from the Veterans Hospital after 30 years.
