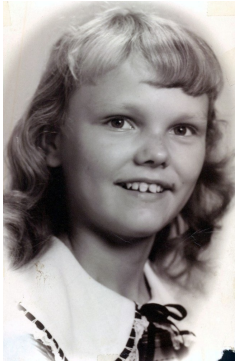


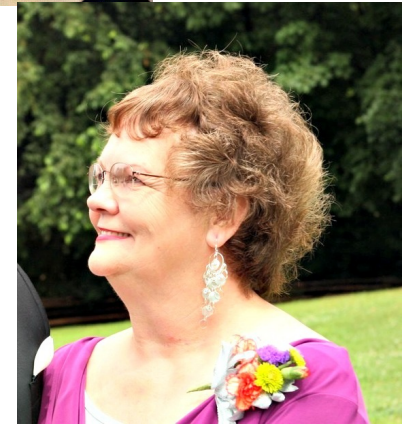
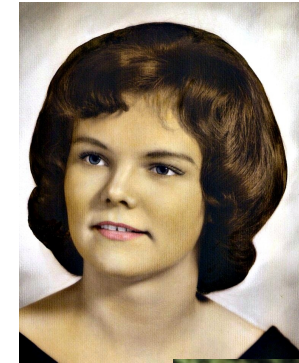
Grace Overton Asher
