

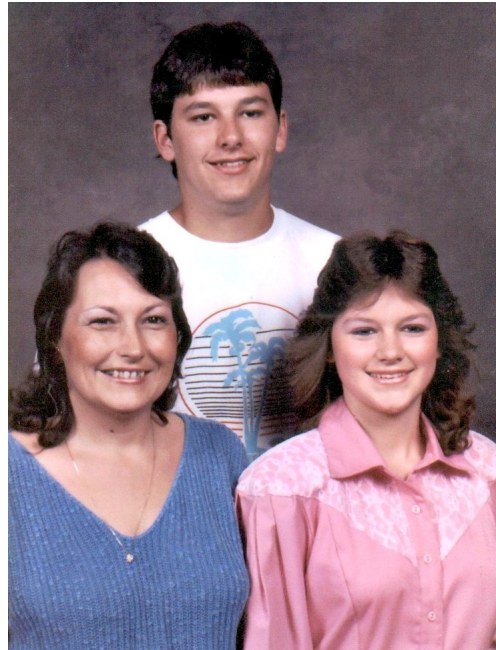
Virginia Lea Roberts
