

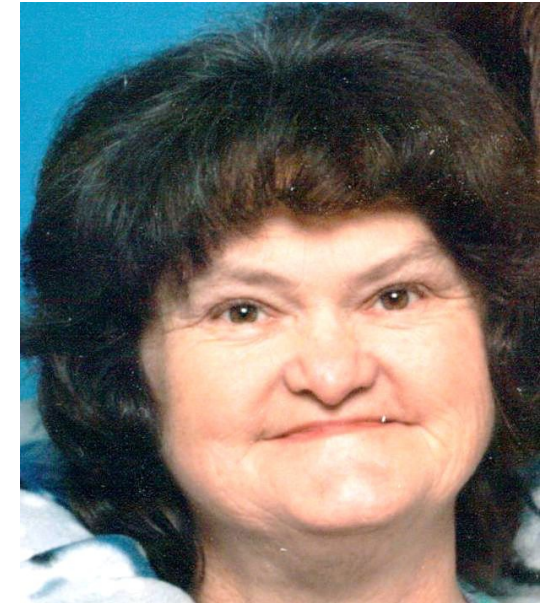
Kathleen Simmons
