

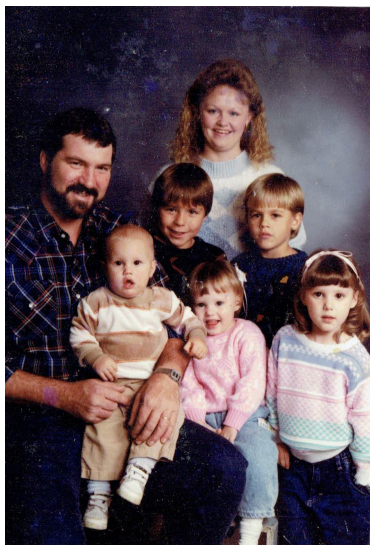
Douglas Earl Smith
