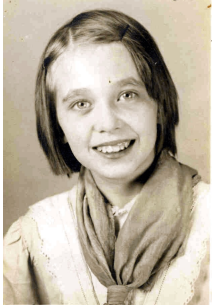


**Etta M. Smith**
