

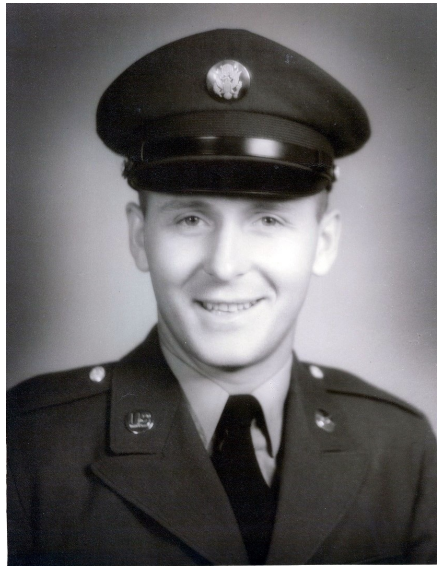
Richard L. Swaffar

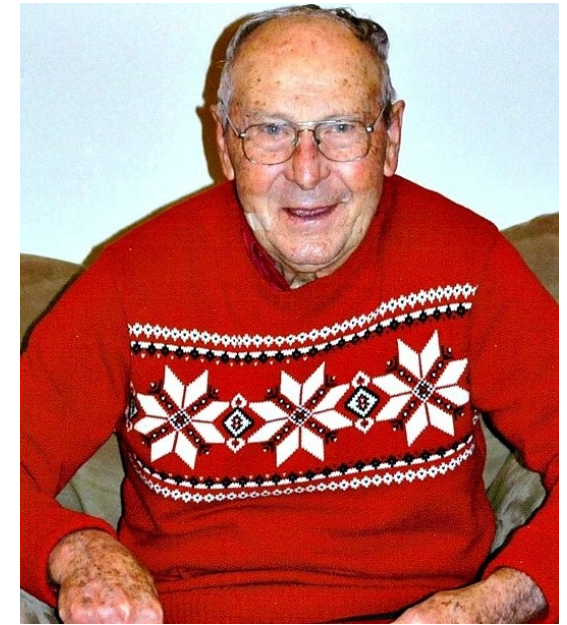
