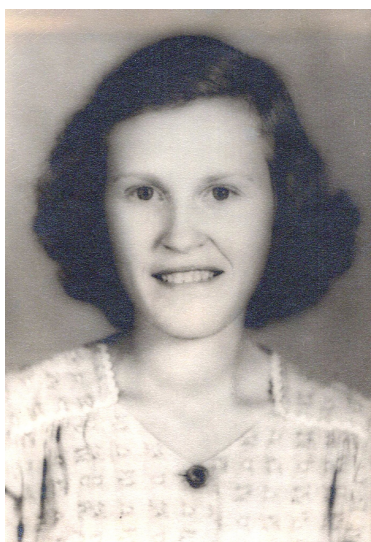


Dorotha Loree Bilbrey Tate
